

## How to write a compelling essay for a university

Even if your grades are not good enough, you can still get into Harvard, not the best TOEFL and GMAT scores can take you to Stanford. It happens often. It's all about a correctly written essay, which shows your ambitions and reveals your talent. In this article, we tell you how to write an essay in English for admission to university abroad.

As the Ivy League Admissions Officers say, the essay is the most memorable part of all admission documents. It shows the applicant as a person. Many people have the same grades and exam scores, but it is an essay, if ordered on a [cheap essay writing service](#), that will help to stand out from this crowd. It shows how you can present yourself, analyze information, express your thoughts and communicate with others in writing.

Do not confuse an essay with a motivation letter or a personal statement. The latter are required almost always, usually one document to choose from. However, top universities such as Harvard or Yale ask for more creative essays on admission. This is how the admissions committee checks if you have creative abilities and what level of compatibility you have with the university.

The important difference between an essay is the limit of words. Each university determines the size of the essay itself. Sometimes you need to fit your thoughts in just 150 words - this is one paragraph. This means that all the answers must be clear and concise, but not dry and not one-word complex.

### What to write about in an essay

Universities post essay topics on their websites in the admissions section. Questions depend on whether you are applying directly to the university or through the Common Application and Coalition Application platforms.

Top universities except for essays require short answers to a few additional questions - supplement questions. You can also find a list of these questions on the universities' website. This is no longer an essay, but a question-and-answer format.

Be ready to write one big essay of 200-300 words and answer 3-10 questions in writing.

### The most frequently asked questions for an essay

- Tell us about your most important achievement.
- How do you spend your time after lessons? Describe the two activities and their importance.
- Describe the person who influenced you and how.
- If you could improve one skill or talent, what would it be and why?
- Which course, person, project, or book is affecting you? How would it affect you?
- Describe your plans for the future.
- What kind of course would you like to take and how it would help you in the future.
- Based on your life experience and that of your family, what would you like to tell us about yourself?
- Describe the difficult situation you have been through.
- Where did you find leadership skills useful?

- What additional information would you like to provide about yourself?
- The more prestigious the university, the more complicated the topics. Look at the website of Yale or Stanford and see for yourself. Among the topics for an essay for the 2020-2021 academic year, there are strong nuts!
